The annual IHT Road Safety Award recognises outstanding achievements which will improve road safety. The award is split into two categories:

- **Reducing All Casualties** – Engineering, enforcement, education or encouragement initiatives to improve road safety techniques and methods to reduce severity of casualties.
- **Reducing Child Casualties** – Initiatives and or techniques focused particularly on improving child safety.

**Criteria for the award are:**

- Clarity of technical submission
- Research into problem
- Quality of technical solution
- Innovation
- Road safety success to date
- Potential road safety success
- Quality of evaluation

All entries should be sent electronically and be limited to explaining how the award meets its selected criteria; taking no more than 1000 words. Further details may be required from short-listed entrants.
